Empowering the women of today and tomorrow

Sambhali Trust is a non-profit charitable organisation based in Jodhpur, whose focus is the development and empowerment of women and girls in Rajasthan.



Founded in 2007, the Trust's aim is to provide free education to the most vulnerable group of women and children.

We help these women break their cycle of poverty and financial dependence on family members, by teaching them valuable practical skills in order for them to earn a living.

This training is given not only to help them develop marketable skills, but also to build up self confidence.

Sambhali Women's Empowerment and Children's Primary Education Centres provide women and girls with vocational training and skills in sewing and embroidery as well as tuition in Primary Education and a variety of workshop. Children's Primary Education Centres are for children who are motivated to continue with or go backreturn to school. They are strengthened withby Primary Education, general knowledge workshops and helped with finishing school homework. These centres are based in Jodhpur and rural village of Setrawa.

Sambhali's Sheerni Microcredit Project aims to form self-help groups of women in rural and urban areas. By regularly saving money, the women have access to loans which enable them to create local enterprises of their own.

Sambhali's No Bad Touch Project educates the community and raises awareness to prevent Child Sexual Abuse, by providing workshops in school and colleges to students, teachers and parents.

Sambhali's Scholarship Project and Boarding Homes give children the opportunity to attend a good school, through individual sponsorship.

Children from the rural villages around Jodhpur district are provided with boarding facilities in Jodhpur. The aim is to break the cycle of illiteracy and poverty.

Sambhali Studio is an income generating programme for graduates of the Empowerment Centres who have an opportunity to work and produce customised garments, accessories and hand-made items for international orders.

Sambhali Boutique sells ethical non-profit hand-made clothes, accessories and gifts that are produced by the women in the Sewing Centres to help provide sustainability for the Trust.

Sambhali Boutique is located in Killikhana, inside Old City, Clock Tower, Jodhpur.
